Police Looking for Two Robbers

The 69th Precinct is asking for the public's assistance in identifying two individuals and a vehicle in connection with a robbery that occurred in Canarsie on Monday, August 12th. They have released surveillance footage of the incident hoping the public can identify them.

Police said two black males approached a 68-year-old man around 12:20 p.m. as he was sitting in his car in the vicinity of East 92nd Street and Avenue L. The two suspects opened the driver's side door of the vehicle and punched the victim in his face. One of the men removed a black plastic bag

containing approximately \$1,700 in cash.

Both thieves then fled the location southbound on East 91st Street in a gold sedan with dark-tinted windows, according to police. The victim was treated at the scene.

Firefighters Battle Two Alarm Fire in Multiple Homes

Firefighters battled a heavy fire in two Marine Park homes on Saturday, August 17th.

Engine Company 309 and Tower Ladder 159 notified incoming companies they had a column of smoke showing and heavy fire coming from the rear of both private homes, located at 1638 and 1640 East 36th Street, between Quentin Road and Avenue P, around 1:25 p.m.

The 33rd Battalion arrived on scene and immediately called for a second alarm, bringing in over 100 firefighters and EMS personnel. As members were extinguishing the fire, they discovered numerous lithium-ion batteries and propane tanks burning in the rear of the houses.

The Hazmat Trio of Hazmat Compa-

ny 1, Engine Company 250 and Hazmat Battalion removed the batteries and placed them in a containment drum.

The incident left three firefighters with minor injuries.

The fire was placed under control at 3:15 p.m. The FDNY Fire Marshal's Office will determine the cause and origin of the fire.

East New York**String of Grand Larcenies at Gateway Center Mall**

The NYPD has released three photos of at least five individuals wanted in connection to a grand larceny pattern that occurred at the Gateway Center mall, within the confines of the 75th Precinct, during June and July. They are asking for the public's assistance in identifying the suspects.

All seven thefts took place at the Nike store, located at 410 Gateway Drive, with the first grand larceny occurring on June 13th and the last incident occurring on July 20th. There were no reported injuries as a result of these thefts, and in each case, the suspects fled on foot in an unknown direction. Details are as follows:

1) On Thursday, June 13th, at approximately 12:20 p.m., two unidentified individuals stole approximately \$2,800

worth of merchandise.

2) On Thursday, July 4th, at approximately 10:15 a.m., four unidentified individuals helped themselves to approximately \$4,600 worth of merchandise.

3) On Saturday, July 6th, at approximately 11:05 a.m., three unidentified individuals took approximately \$3,100 worth of merchandise.

4) On Saturday, July 13th, at approximately 1:15 p.m., three unidentified individuals removed approximately \$7,200 worth of merchandise.

5) On Sunday, July 14th, at approximately 6 p.m., an unidentified individual stole approximately \$2,200 worth of merchandise.

6) On Tuesday, July 16th, at approximately 10:10 a.m.,

two unidentified individuals swiped approximately \$2,900 worth of merchandise.

7) On Saturday, July 20th, at approximately 10:10 a.m., two unidentified individuals got away with approximately \$3,600 worth of merchandise.

District 22 Prepares for New School Year

Members of Community District Education Council 22 (CEC 22) held their final meeting of the summer on Tuesday evening, August 6th, at the District office, located at 5619 Flatlands Avenue. The meeting was also streamed live to the public via Zoom and was led by Interim President Nadine Friedman.

During the meeting, Superintendent Julia Bove announced that the Department of Education has released their 2024-25 calendar, available online at: schools.nyc.gov/calendar/2024-2025-school-year-calendar. She reminded parents to complete the Family Inquiry Form if they haven't already done so. The superintendent also encouraged parents to have their children undergo a full physical, including eye exams and hearing tests, prior to the first day of the new school year, Thursday, September 5th, to ensure their students are ready for success. She invited families to attend one of the many backpack and school supply giveaways being held throughout the area, hosted by local elected officials and community organizations, to ensure their students have all the tools they need to have a productive school year.

There was also a valuable discussion between educators and adminis-

trators over the rather rigorous nature of the new HMH Into Reading curriculum. In the elementary grades, the major focus is on the fundamentals of reading: phonics, phonemic awareness, vocabulary, fluency and comprehension, as well as writing. Since it is common for teachers to use the summer break to prepare an entire school year's worth of lesson plans, it was the perfect opportunity for participants to compare notes. Some were able to share their resources and techniques in order to help others adjust this year's 180-day pacing calendar to accommodate all learners, including those with special needs who may need a little extra time to fully master various aspects of the curricula. All things considered, it seems the District is shaping up to have a very productive school year.

The next meeting of CEC 22 will be held on Tuesday, September 3rd, at 6:30 p.m. – location to be announced.

Film Shoot Spotted in BK: Godfather of Harlem Season 4 Takes Over Avenue N

One of Brooklyn's bustling business districts saw a touch of Hollywood glamour on Friday morning, August 9th, as the filming crew for *Godfather of Harlem* took over the corner of Avenue N and East 59th Street, right next to Landi's Pork Store. The normally busy area was filled with the buzz of trucks, cameras and crew members setting up for the shoot. This time, the scene was set in a makeshift jewelry store, cleverly converted from a former travel agency.

Fans of the series were thrilled to catch a glimpse of Rome Flynn, widely known for his role as Zende Forrester on *The Bold and the Beautiful*, as he portrays the show's new character, notorious mobster Frank Lucas. Flynn's appearance drew attention from curious onlookers, eager to see what the new season will bring. Flynn was in costume, sporting a one-piece blue jumpsuit coverall with the insignia "Tri-State Electric & Gas Co.," accessorized by a brown leather toolbelt.

In a correction from our last report, producer Jim Acheson clarified that *Godfather of Harlem Season 4* will be streaming on MGM+, not EPIX as previously mentioned. For those who want to catch up, the previous seasons are

available on *Hulu*.

The street was lined with vintage cars, adding to the nostalgic atmosphere of the show's 1960s setting. As the director called, "Roll 'em...and action!," the neighborhood experienced a brief, thrilling moment of Hollywood magic right in the heart of Mill Basin's commercial hub.

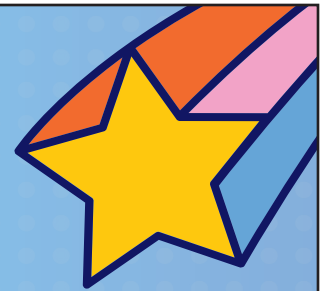

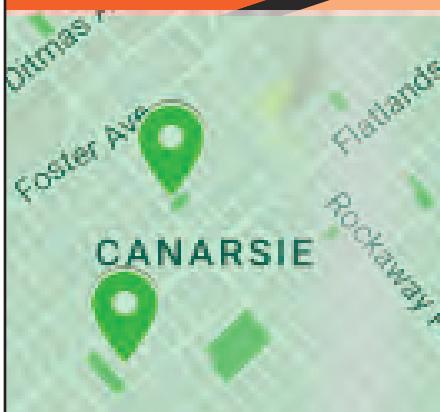
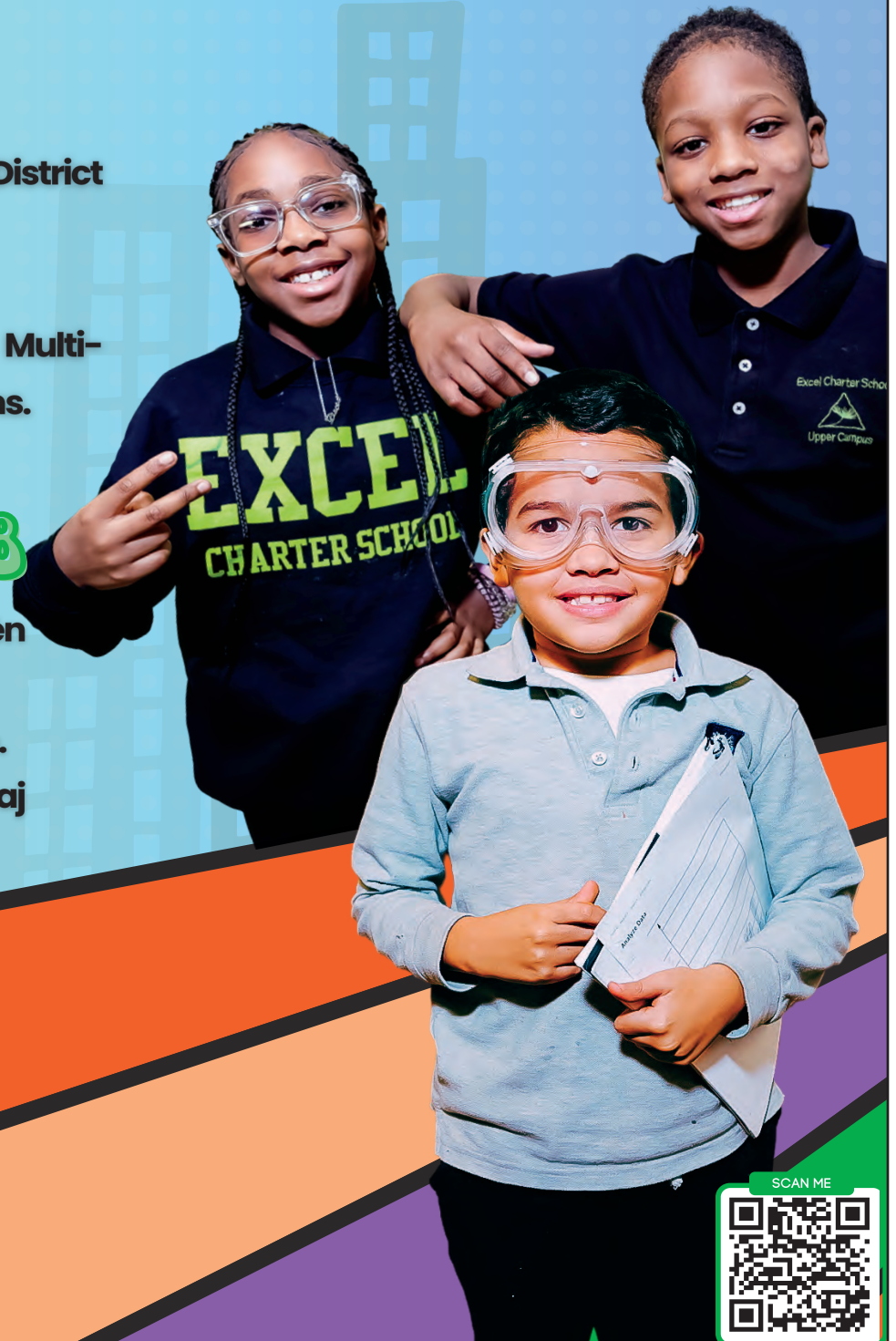

A Look Back at Canarsie's History – Part III

After Season Dance Given by Volunteer Life Guards - 1932

Editor's Note:

A Canarsie native named Douglas Torborg, now living in Florida, mailed an original program for a dance that took place in Canarsie in 1932, and it is our honor to share this piece of history with our readers. The occasion was the "After Season Dance Given by Volunteer Life Guards of Canarsie Beach," and the event took place on October 1, 1932 at the Arcadia Inn at the Canarsie Shore.

Douglas tells us that his father, Harold, was the Secretary for the dance, and his brother, Albert, was the Crew Commodore. Harold was born in Canarsie in 1906 and lived there his entire life. He had polio and walked with a cane. Harold was nicknamed "Duck" because he was such a good swimmer. Duck was the manager of Heinrich's Bar

and Restaurant, which was located at 135 Conklin Avenue until 1965.

A special thank you to Douglas Torborg for sharing this fascinating find with us, a 92-year-old pamphlet, which is in surprisingly good condition.

Ira Kluger, co-president of the Canarsie Historical Society, will be sharing historical facts about the advertisers in this pamphlet in a weekly column.

Reinhardt's Bakery: At the time this journal was published, Reinhardt's Bakery still occupied its original location at 9412 (now 9414) Avenue L. It was owned by Anton Reinhardt, who is believed to have bought an existing bakery on the site (the Sanitary Bakery).

In the late 1930s, Mr. Reinhardt purchased land at 9402-9404 Avenue L and erected a new build-

ing containing both a bakery and a coffee shop. The coffee shop changed hands several times, and, at various points in time, was known as Landau's, Hutter's and Dard's. There may have been additional owners whose names I do not recall.

Reinhardt's original location was taken over by a wine and liquor store. Some older Canarsiens may remember the liquor store's distinctive, asymmetrical storefront. Unfortunately, after the liquor store closed, a neighboring discount/variety store expanded into the space formerly occupied by the liquor store, at which time the distinctive storefront was obliterated.

Sanitary Laundry: Little is known about the Sanitary Laundry, other than the fact that it was located near the Canarsie shore. It was announced in the *Canarsie Courier* published on Thursday, August 31, 1961 that the Canarsie Laundry was celebrating its 40th anniversary. The address is listed in the *Courier* article as 1769 East 93rd Street, between Seaview Avenue and the Belt Parkway, which states that the laundry has been at the same address since it opened in October 1921. However, the address listed in the journal is 2118-20 Rockaway Avenue. I believe that this discrepancy resulted from the city government's renaming and renumbering of streets. The renowned historian, John F. Denton, stated that the laundry was owned by Henry Quaritius and his partner, Stanley Rowland.

Lazar's 5 – 9 – 19c Store: This store was located at 1370 Rockaway Parkway, a building which has a very interesting history. Between 1910 and now, the store was occupied by so many different businesses that it would literally take an encyclopedia to list all of them. The earliest known occupant, in 1910, was Inglesby Brothers, a furniture store. By 1915, the store was occupied by the Parkway Laundry. The store eventually came to be occupied by Louis Naham's hardware store. In 1926, Sarah Naham published a newspaper advertisement announcing the sale of the hardware business, presumably to Charles Solotoff, who is believed to have relocated it to 1399 Rockaway Parkway, on the ground floor

of the Jerry Building. 1370 Rockaway then came to be occupied by Lazar's. However, until this journal was discovered, I was unable to identify the nature of Lazar's business. A newspaper article published in 1931 announced the death of Sarah L. Silver of 1370 Rockaway Parkway. I have been unable to ascertain whether Sarah Naham and Sarah L. Silver is one and the same person. The store is currently occupied by a bar.

General Service Coal Co.: We know that the building, an ancient house at 1408 Rockaway Parkway, was originally occupied by Ripp's undertaking establishment. Mrs. Ripp eventually sold the building at 1408 Rockaway Parkway and relocated the undertaking establishment to Avenue G and East 95th Street. The exact address is unknown. The storefront at 1408 Rockaway Parkway later became a restaurant. At some point in time, the restaurant was divided into two separate stores. We do not know precisely when this subdivision occurred. As this journal indicates, on a later page, that in addition to the General Service Coal Co., 1408 Rockaway Parkway was occupied by Gus's Coffee Shop. We know that the subdivision of the store took place by 1932, the year in which the journal was published. Some older residents of Canarsie may recall the southern portion occupied by Top's Bar, and the northern portion by a luncheonette-type restaurant, which later evolved into a shoe store. This building, as well as the adjacent building at 1404-1406 Rockaway Parkway, was demolished following a major fire.

Joe's Billiard Parlor: This business was located on the ground floor of an ancient hotel located at the corner of Avenue K and East 95th Street. The hotel changed hands several times and was known by various names over the years. When the hotel closed, the building was occupied by Paul Safina, who converted it to a cabinet factory. The ground floor remained occupied by various storefront businesses, including a candy store and the billiard parlor. Unfortunately, this building, along with many other historic buildings, was demolished to clear the site for Canarsie High School.

Miller's Kosher Delicatessen & Lunch Room: During the 1920s, this store, located at Ave-

nue L and East 92nd Street, was occupied by Konweiser's Kosher Delicatessen. By the 1930s, the business had been sold and became Miller's. The store was later occupied by Fran's Bar. Subsequently, Joe's Pizzeria, which was located farther down the block, relocated to this store. The pizzeria subsequently underwent several changes in ownership and name. I believe that the store is presently occupied by a day care center.

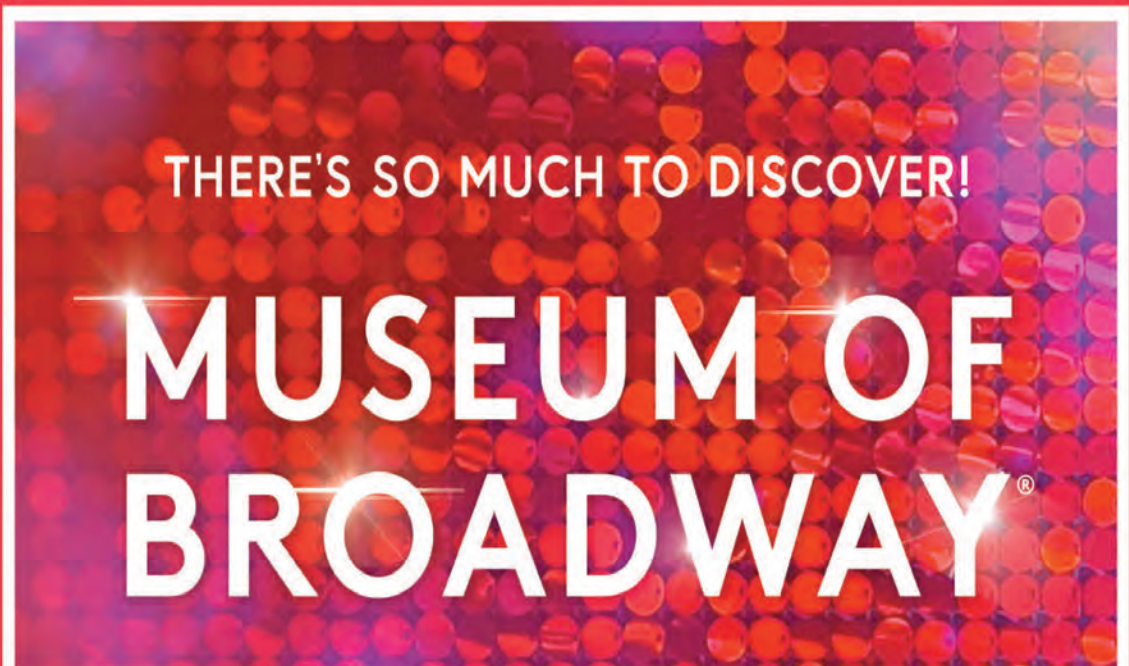

A performance by Jewish singer Cantor Shea Rubinstein on Wednesday, August 14th, added another highlight to the Marine Park Summer Concert Series, offering diverse music and entertainment events.

Despite being shortened due to early mosquito spraying to combat West Nile Virus, the concert delivered a powerful and poignant message. Rubinstein's performance resonated deeply with the audience, especially during a time of turmoil and war in Israel, coupled with rising concerns about antisemitism at home.

One of the standout moments was Rubinstein's rendition of "Bring Him Home" from *Les Misérables*. He chose this song to draw a parallel between its lyrics and current global events, reflecting on the struggles faced by Jewish communities and the hope for the safe return of hostages, both American and Israeli. The cantor also paid tribute to the armed forces, emphasizing that beyond politics, we are all parents, children and human beings.

Rubinstein also performed "Memories," a song he wrote about a concentration camp survivor. The heartfelt lyrics told the story of a grandfather remembering what he endured and grandchild asking him about the tears he sheds, a

poignant reminder of the lasting impact of history on the present. The concert then shifted to a more upbeat tone with Rubinstein performing popular songs in Hebrew, including "Hallelujah" and "House of the Lord."

Accompanied by Tzvi Hamel on keyboard, Rubinstein wrapped up his set with an energetic final song in Hebrew. Following his performance, DJ Scott Yahney took over, entertaining the crowd with oldies but goodies, including "Fly Me to the Moon," Barry Manilow's "Can't Smile Without You," and Neil Diamond's "Sweet Caroline," which had some in the audience singing along.

Yahney continued with classics like "Moon River," "New York, New York" and a crowd-pleasing rendition of "What a Wonderful World" in a Louis Armstrong-style voice, much to the delight of the attendees.

The evening also featured a raffle, with three lucky winners taking home bottles of kosher wine. Assemblywoman Jaime Williams and Community Board 18 District Manager Sue Ann Partnow were in attendance, with Rubinstein offering them special thanks. The event was made possible with the help of Yahney, who provided the sound equipment and worked the soundboard.

The Marine Park concerts are spon-

sored by Assemblywoman Jaime Williams, Marine Park Alliance, Kings Plaza and Nick's Lobster House, among others, in coordination with State Senators Simcha Felder and Roxanne Persaud, and District Leader Frank Seddio, and in partnership with Millennium Development, NYC Parks and the Marine Park Community Association.

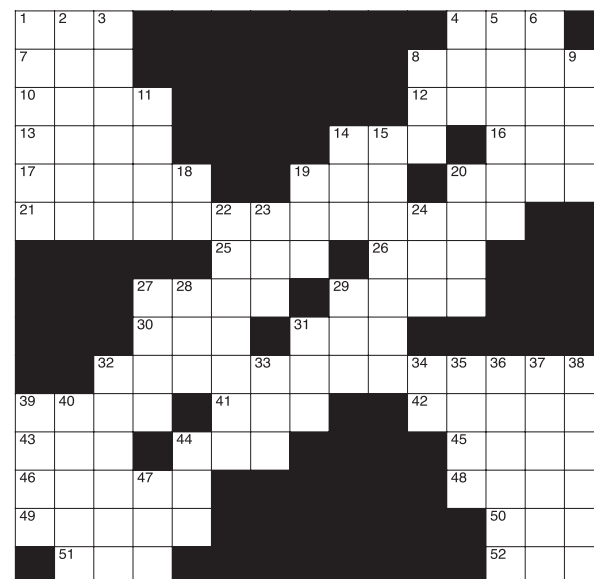

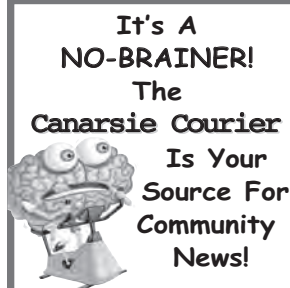
