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The Dental Debt Trap

When most people visit the dentist, they expect to leave with a treatment plan — not thousands of dollars in unexpected debt. Yet New York City's recent lawsuit against Canarsie Family Dentistry and New York Family Dentistry alleges that some patients, including seniors, Medicaid and Medicare recipients, and other neighbors, were misled about treatment costs and insurance coverage, pressured into unnecessary procedures and steered into high-interest financing they did not fully understand. The practices deny the allegations, and the case will be decided in court.

Whatever the outcome, the lawsuit underscores a larger issue: medical debt is increasingly a consumer protection issue as much as a healthcare one.

National research shows that millions of Americans carry medical or dental debt. Beyond unpaid bills, medical debt can damage credit, limit access to housing and loans, and trap families in financial hardship long after the medical appointment is over.

That's why agencies like New York

City's Department of Consumer and Worker Protection (DCWP) matter. Their job is to investigate deceptive business practices, enforce consumer protection laws and seek restitution for consumers who may have been harmed.

If you believe you experienced deceptive billing, were pressured into signing financing agreements or were told your insurance could not be used despite advertising to the contrary, don't ignore it. Keep copies of treatment plans, loan documents, receipts, billing statements, insurance paperwork, emails and text messages. Then file a complaint with the DCWP at nyc.gov/consumers. You may also contact the New York State Attorney General's Consumer Frauds Bureau if you believe you were the victim of deceptive business practices.

Patients should also know the warning signs. Never feel pressured to sign financial documents while in pain. Ask for a written treatment estimate, request an explanation of your insurance benefits and don't hesitate to seek a second opinion before agreeing to major procedures or financing.



No one should have to choose between caring for their health and protecting their financial future. As this lawsuit reminds us, informed consent should apply not only to treatment — but also to the financial decisions that come with it.

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A Night of Moths and Moonlight

Moths took center stage at Floyd Bennett Field (FBF) as the Jamaica Bay-Rockaway Parks Conservancy (JBRPC) welcomed the community for an evening of learning about nighttime pollinators and their role in the local ecosystem.

“Moth Ball – A Night of Moths and Moonlight” took place on Monday, July 20th, and featured moth-viewing stations, black lights, educational activities and trees painted with a homemade mixture, including sugar water, molasses, beer and mashed banana, to attract moths.

“We are celebrating moths tonight and looking for moths here at Floyd Bennett Field, part of the Jamaica Bay ecosystem,” JBRPC Executive Director Terri Carta said. She pointed out that moths are often overlooked as pollinators. “We think about bees when

we hear about pollination. Sometimes we think about butterflies, but hardly ever do we think about moths as pollinators,” she said. “Tonight is all about raising awareness and celebrating these amazing pollinators that live around here.”

This was JBRPC’s first event dedicated to moths and



is part of a larger two-year pollinator initiative. The program provides educational activities for schools, families and community members and also works to restore habitats and plant native species that attract pollinators. The Conservancy is also working with NYC Parks and its native plant nursery at FBF to grow and transplant plants that support pollinators. The New York Community Trust and the New York State Pollinator Fund provided grants for the initiative.

Carta said protecting pollinators in cities is especially important because natural habitats are threatened by development and crowded areas. “We need to make sure that we’re conserving enough habitat for these pollinators to survive because they are depending on us, and we are also depending on them,” Carta said.

During the event, guests visited observation stations with lights and white sheets to attract moths. Experts were there to help identify the different species. Carta mentioned that Jamaica Bay could have hundreds of moth species, which is much more than the number of butterfly species in the area. She encouraged people to plant native, pollinator-friendly plants, volunteer at park cleanups and community gardens, and help raise awareness about local wildlife.

Delilah McBride, director of education and public programs for JBRPC, said the turnout exceeded her expectations. “I am thrilled,” she said. “I’m so excited that we brought so many moth enthusiasts to the park. This has exceeded my expectations, and I’m excited for it to become dark and to see what moths show up.”

McBride said more than 85 people attended, including many children, even though the event took place from 8 to 10 p.m. on a Monday. The Nottage family from Bushwick was among the visitors. They told the *Canarsie Courier* they were excited to learn about moths and enjoyed having an educational activity to do together as a family.

The program was scheduled to line up with National Moth Week and other events happening around Jamaica Bay that week. McBride said the goal was to make environmental education welcoming for both experienced naturalists and families looking for a fun activity. “We’re trying to bridge that gap between the naturalists who already want to do this and people who just want to do something fun and cool,” she said. “We want to find an entry point for everyone into these activities.”

Chaplain Calls for Compassion and Community Support Choose Mercy, Shared Responsibility and Healing over Fear

As a chaplain serving within the New York State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (NYSDOCCS), I have spent a lifetime walking corridors of despair, yet still, my life's work is tethered to a profound, spiritual truth: no human being is ever beyond redemption, and no neighbor is truly a stranger. Day in and day out, I look into the eyes of men who have stumbled, men who carry the heavy burdens of systemic failure, broken pathways and spiritual exhaustion.

When we hear news of the new transitional home for single adult men arriving on Kings Highway, the immediate reaction in many neighborhoods is apprehension, heated anxiety and protest. Fear whispers that we must bar our gates and reject those who lack a roof over their head and bread on their table. But the teachings of Rastafari – and the foundational tenants of every sacred tradition – teach us otherwise. We are commanded to look out for the vulnerable, to build bridges where there are chasms and to recognize that community is measured not by how it excludes the broken but by how it helps them stand back up. True community, safety and spiritual wealth come from rehabilitation and shelter, not from locking our doors and hardening our hearts against vulnerable men who are part of the human family.

The transition of spaces to accommodate single men in our boroughs reflects a wider societal plan. These are not faceless threats; they are sons, brothers and fathers. Many are navigating the crushing undertow of economic displacement, mental health struggles or the difficult transition from institutional settings.

To my fellow south Brooklyn residents protesting along Kings Highway: I hear your desire for safer streets, clean blocks and thriving local commerce. Those are righteous desires. Yet safety and security are not achieved by casting our most distressed into the cold shadows of the streets or pushing them further into hopelessness. True safety is born through stabilization, supportive case management and human connection. When you welcome a facility with a commitment to active oversight and community partnership, we transform an invisible crisis into an organized path toward permanent housing and personal restoration.

Let us lay down the spirit of division. The Creator does not look upon a person sleeping on the streets struggling with past mistakes with contempt and neither should we. Opening a shelter on Kings Highway is an invitation to practice radical empathy in southern Brooklyn. I reject the notion to treat unhoused males as a plague, yet rather like the Prodigal Son needing a safe harbor to rebuild their lives. There is divine breath within every one of us (I-n-I), and a brother on the street reflects ourselves as a society.

I call upon local faith leaders, fellow chaplains, pastors, imams and rabbis alike to offer their spiritual and pastoral care to residents at this facility. The facilities that these men are coming from are familiar with our titles, roles and job duties. Untreated housing, instability, trauma and lack of foundational support push desperate men from the street into the criminal justice pipeline. Let us lead the way on the community advisory board, not yelling NIMBY from a megaphone offering zero solutions. Fellow first responders, nurses, caregivers, social workers and volunteer residents: let us lock arms – not in combat, but with cooperative stewardship. Let us demand transparency, excellent opera-

tional standards and robust supportive services, but let us do so with open, diligent and working hands rather than closed hearts. By welcoming these men with dignity, we do not diminish our neighborhood; we elevate it, turning the corner of Brooklyn into a true sanctuary of collective grace.

Let the hungry be fed
The naked clothed
The sick nourished
The aged protected
And the infant cared for.

Assemblywoman Jaime Williams joined hundreds of residents, veterans, clergy, elected officials and community leaders at a candlelight vigil in Ozone Park, Queens, on July 27th to honor the life and sacrifice of U.S. Army Staff Sgt. Angel Sarah Rampersad, who was killed on July 17th during an Iranian missile strike on Muwaffaq Salti Air Base in Jordan.

Hosted by the Ozone Park Residents Block Association, the vigil brought together the community outside the Rampersad family home on 96th Street, where mourners gathered with candles, American flags and prayers to pay tribute to the 28-year-old soldier and support her grieving family.

Williams, who represents Brooklyn's 59th Assembly District, said attending the vigil held special meaning because she and the Rampersad family share Trinidadian roots.

"As a fellow Trinidadian, it was deeply important for me to stand in solidarity with the Rampersad family," Williams said. "The outpouring of love and support from the community and people from far beyond was truly moving."

She asked that prayers continue for the Rampersad family while also remembering the three other American service members who lost their lives

in the same attack: 1st Lt. Tyler James Feehan, Pvt. Isabella Gonzales and Sgt. Michael Emmanuel Swinton.

"Thank you for your service, Staff Sgt. Angel Sarah Rampersad," Williams said. "May God bless her memory, bring comfort to her family and loved ones, and God bless America."

On July 31st, Rampersad was laid to rest with full military honors following a funeral service in Queens. A ceremonial motorcade traveled down Cross Bay Boulevard, where thousands lined the route waving American flags before the procession continued beneath four FDNY ladder arches to Long Island National Cemetery in Farmingdale, where the hometown hero was laid to rest.

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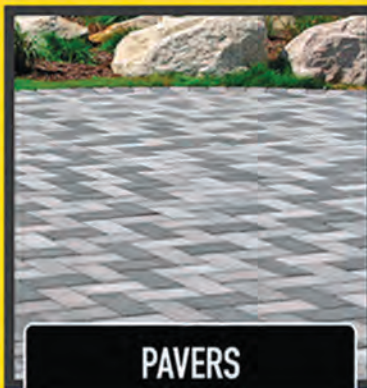

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OBH Dedicates Plaque in Honor of Late Trailblazing Doctor

On Friday, July 24th, the staff of One Brooklyn Health (OBH) held a Plaque Dedication and Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony to honor the legacy of the late Dr. Patricia O'Neill, former head of the trauma unit at Brookdale Hospital Medical Center (BHMC).

The ceremony took place in the newly renovated Trauma Bay at 1 Brookdale Plaza and was attended by OBH leadership including Chief Executive Officer Dr. Sandra Scott, who spoke about the vision she and O'Neill had for a state-of-the-art trauma bay, someday, that would have the best possible environment for healing. "And today is that day," Scott announced. "While I would much prefer to have her standing here with me, it is my honor and my pleasure to have her family here. I want you to know that her footprints and her fingerprints are on every aspect of this trauma bay, and we're going to live up to her expectations and continue to deliver the highest quality of care possible," she added.

O'Neill, whose medical career began as a nurse caring for patients at their bedside, was hailed by OBH leadership and former colleagues at BHMC as a pioneer after she became a physician, then a surgeon and later a trauma surgeon "who played a pivotal role in advancing trauma care, mentoring future surgeons and strengthening emergency services for the Central Brooklyn community."

“She truly broke many glass ceilings,” BHMC’s Chief of Surgery Dr. Kavi Kothuru announced. “This dedication is so meaningful. This plaque is going to be a monument and daily reminder to the entire team here on how to carry her dedication, her empathy, her surgical skills to our injured patients every single day,” he stated.

Several elected officials including Congressman Hakeem Jeffries, Brooklyn Borough President Antonio Reynoso, Councilwoman Mercedes Narcisse and Councilman Chris Banks, as well as a representative from State Senator Roxanne Persaud's office, also attended the ceremony. They gave brief remarks praising O'Neill, a visionary who, unfortunately, did not live to see her dream of a state-of-the-art trauma bay in a medically underserved area in Brooklyn realized.

“High-quality affordable healthcare should be a right available to everyone, and this trauma bay will help bring that right to life in Brownsville, in East New York and in East Flatbush,” Jeffries asserted as he lauded O’Neill’s innovation and expressed gratitude for “the incredibly compassionate, comprehensive and caring service that she provided.”

The congressman also thanked O'Neill's family, several who are also in the medical field, for their presence and commitment "to carrying out the spirit of service that she provided to the people of this community, consistent with the notion that we believe that in this country, access to high quality and affordable healthcare can't simply be of privilege, available only to the wealthy, the well-off and the well-connected," Jeffries stressed.

“Just hearing that this was her vision makes us filled with so much love and pride,” O’Neill’s niece, Erin O’Hanlon, who was accompanied by her cousins Megan Mulholland, Shannon Gulbin and Laura Schneider, told the *Canarsie Courier*. “We’re truly honored by this and so happy to be included,” Ann Schneider, O’Neill’s twin sister, added.

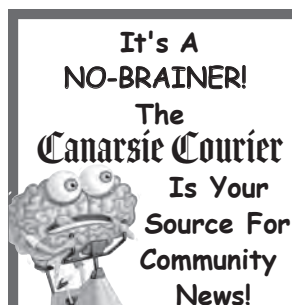

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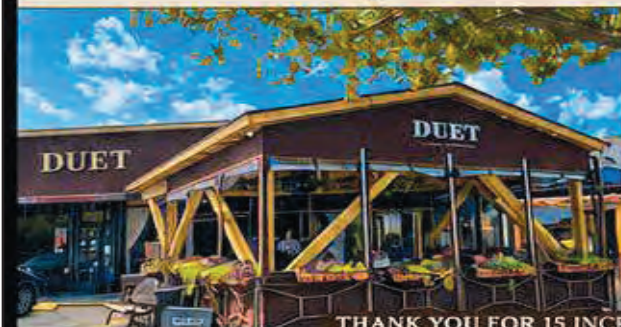
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
